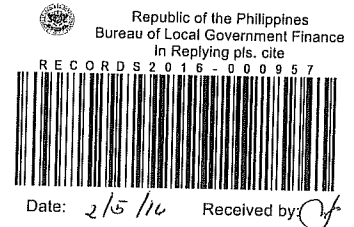

**NOTICE OF PAYMENT OF REAL PROPERTY TAX IN PASIG CITY  
FOR THE CALENDAR YEAR 2016**

Notice is hereby given to all real property owners in Pasig City that pursuant to Republic Act No. 7160, otherwise known as the Local Government Owned Code of 1991 and Ordinance No. 25 Series of 1992 as Amended under Ordinance No. 24 series of 1994, known as the Pasig City Revenue Code, the following tax imposed which is due and payable on the 1<sup>st</sup> day of January 2016 as follows:

1. 1.5% BASIC TAX (RESIDENTIAL)
2. 2% BASIC TAX (Commercial, Industrial)
3. 1% Special Education Fund (SEF)
4. 5% AD VALOREM TAX on Idle lands in addition to Basic Tax.

The said taxes may however be paid in four (4) equal installments without interest at the option of the taxpayers, as follows:

- 1<sup>st</sup> Installment – on or before March 31, 2016
- 2<sup>nd</sup> Installment – on or before June 30, 2016
- 3<sup>rd</sup> Installment – on or before September 30, 2016
- 4<sup>th</sup> Installment – on or before December 31, 2016

Both the basic and the additional SEF must be collected simultaneously.

The taxpayers with no delinquency, who shall pay their real property taxes in full on or before March 31, 2016, are entitled to a TEN PERCENT (10%) DISCOUNT. Those who opt to pay quarterly are entitled to a FIVE PERCENT (5%) DISCOUNT if they pay on or before the above mentioned dates.

Upon the expiration of the periods given, an interest of TWO PERCENT (2%) per month not to exceed THIRTY SIX (36) MONTHS or SEVENTY TWO PERCENT (72%) shall be imposed upon delinquent properties for failure to pay the basic real property tax or any other tax levied under Title II Real Property Taxation of the Revenue Code.

Taxpayers are encouraged to pay on time at the Pasig City Treasurer's Office to avoid the application of the remedies for the collection of real property tax such as administrative action thru levy on real property or by judicial action.
