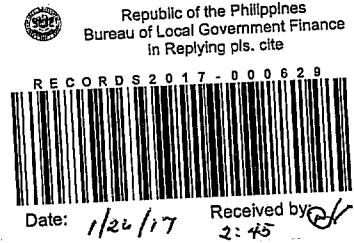

**NOTICE OF PAYMENT OF THE 1% BASIC REAL PROPERTY TAX
 AND 1% SPECIAL EDUCATION FUND TAX FOR CALENDAR YEAR
 2017 IN THE PROVINCE OF ANTIQUE**

NOTICE is hereby served that pursuant to the provisions of Republic Act No. 7160 of the Local Government Code of 1991, specifically Sections 233, 235, 246, 2150 and 255 of the code, the one percent (1%) Basic Real Property Tax and the additional one percent (1%) Special Education Fund for the Calendar Year 2017 maybe paid in four (4) equal installments without interest at the option of the taxpayers as follows:

- 1st Installment ----- on or before March 31, 2017
- 2nd Installment ----- on or before June 30, 2017
- 3rd Installment ----- on or before September 30, 2017
- 4th Installment ----- on or before December 31, 2017

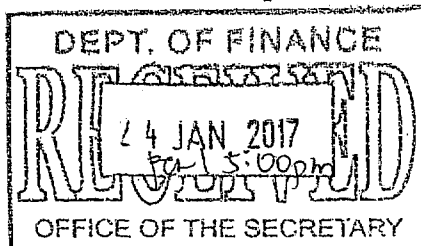
The Taxpayer shall be entitled to discount in the manner as follows:

- PROMPT PAYMENT – 10% - When the current year tax is paid in full on or before the end of first quarter and/or within the quarter it falls due, if the taxpayer opts for a quarterly installment;
- FULL PAYMENT – 15% - - When taxpayer pays his current year's tax on or before January 15 of the current year;
- ADVANCE PAYMENT – 20% - When the tax due for the ensuing year is paid on or before the 31st of December of the current year

The one percent (1%) Basic Tax and the additional one percent (1%) Special Education Fund Tax shall be collected simultaneously.

Failure to pay the said installments on or before the dates indicated above, shall subject the taxpayers to the payment of interest at the rate of two percent (2%) for each month of delinquency, until the delinquent taxes shall have been fully paid. After the end of the year for which the taxes are due and real property taxes are not paid, the civil and judicial remedies provided for in the code to enforce the collection thereof would be availed by this office.

Payment of such taxes will be made in the Office of the Municipal Treasurer of the municipality where the properties are located, or in any of the Office of the Provincial, City or Municipal Treasurer of the Philippines, provided, however, that the concerned offices have the complete and updated records of payment of the said property.
