**NOTICE OF PAYMENT OF 1% BASIC REAL PROPERTY TAX AND
1% SPECIAL EDUCATION FUND TAX IN THE PROVINCE OF NEGROS ORIENTAL
FOR THE YEAR 2019**

NOTICE is hereby given that pursuant to Section 233, Chapter 4, Section 235, Chapter 5, Section 246 and 251, Chapter 6 of Republic Act 7160, other wise known as the Local Government Code of 1991, having been adopted and embodied in an enabling Provincial Tax Ordinance No. 1, series of 1994. The Basic Real Property Tax and Special Education Fund Tax for the Calendar Year 2019 at the rate of one percent (1%) each, shall become due and payable on the 1st day of January. The said taxes maybe paid in four (4) equal installments without interest at the option of the taxpayer, as follows:

| 1st installment | - On or before March 31, 2019 |
| 2nd installment | - On or before June 30, 2019 |
| 3rd installment | - On or before September 30, 2019 |
| 4th installment | - On or before December 31, 2019 |

Pursuant to Resolution No. 688, series of 2003, dated August 20, 2003, there is hereby granted tax discount on all real properties free from tax delinquency at the following rates:

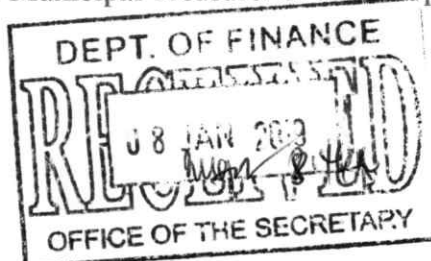

| 1. Advance payment | - 20% discount (if paid in full on or before December 31 for the succeeding year's taxes) |
| 2. Prompt payment | - 20% discount (if paid in full on or before January 31 of the current year's taxes) |
| | - 15% discount (if paid in full from February 1 up to March 31 of the current year's taxes) |
| 3. Installment payment | - 10% discount (real property tax payment if paid by installment before the quarter the tax is due) |



Failure to pay Real Property Taxes for the Basic Tax and Special Education Fund (SEF) Tax within the scheduled date of payment as reflected above shall subject the taxpayer concerned to an interest of two percent (2%) for each month of delinquency, provided, however that in no case shall the total interest on the unpaid tax or portion thereof exceeds thirty six (36) months.

Remedies guaranteed for by law to enforce tax collection will be availed of by this office on delinquent taxes which have remained unpaid at the end of the year.

Owners of real property or persons having legal interest therein are requested to pay their taxes at the Office of the Municipal Treasurer where the properties are located or in any Provincial, City or Municipal Treasurer of the Philippines whichever is convenient to them.
