TO : All BLGF Central and Regional Directors; All Provincial, City and Municipal Treasurers and Assistant Treasurers; and Others Concerned

SUBJECT : **BLGF Electronic Financial Reporting Tool: Covid-19 Response of LGUs** Annual Report on Bayanihan Grant Receipts and Expenditures and Other Donations Received by Provinces, Cities and Municipalities

As directed by the Secretary of Finance and in line with BLGF Memorandum Circular No. 014.2020<sup>1</sup>, all local treasurers shall update the monitoring tool for the receipts and expenditures relative to the implementation of Covid-19 programs, projects, and activities of provinces, cities, and municipalities as of **31 December 2020**.

In this regard, all Provincial, City and Municipal Treasurers are hereby directed to accomplish the online LGU report at https://cutt.ly/Fkat2ie effective immediately, and to complete the required forms no later than Friday, 19 February 2021. In accomplishing the report, the Local Treasurer, or his/her duly authorized representative, should gather first all the data requirements, as specified in *Annex A* of this Circular. Please note, that the questionnaire includes already questions on transfer and utilization of LGU trust fund.

Further, based on the LGU reports as of 30 June 2020, this Bureau noted in Part IV of the reporting tool that there are disbursements and utilizations in some LGUs of more than the amount of the Bayanihan Grant released to them. As such, all local treasurers are reminded to thoroughly review the report and ensure that the amounts disbursed and utilized were funds coming solely from Bayanihan Grant.

All BLGF Central and Regional Directors are hereby instructed to immediately disseminate this Circular, to monitor the strict compliance of all LGUs within their respective jurisdiction, and to provide the necessary technical assistance in accomplishing the report.

All concerned shall be guided accordingly.

#### Data Requirements to Accomplish the BLGF Electronic Financial Reporting Tool: Covid-19 Response of LGUs

#### **Bayanihan Grant to Provinces**

In this Section, the utilization of the Bayanihan Grant for Provinces, per DBM LBC No. 126 for Covid-19-related programs, projects, and activities (PPAs) of province, should be reported, in accordance with the expenditure classifications and menu provided under said LBC.

Under LBC No. 126, the Bayanihan Grant shall be exclusively used by the provinces to:

Item 3.5.1: Augment the funding requirements for the operation of provincial, district, and other local hospitals operated by the provincial government, for Covid-19-related P/A/Ps and expenses; and

Item 3.5.2: Operation and maintenance of duly established provincial checkpoints related to COVID-19, such as provision of foods, medicines/vitamins, personal protective equipment, and disinfecting supplies for the exclusive use of provincial government employees and personnel concerned, including those hired under Contract of Service and Job Order schemes.

It is understood that the use of the Bayanihan Grant for this purpose shall augment, and not duplicate, the funds allocated for National Government agencies, like the PNP and the AFP, among others.

For detailed monitoring, sub-activities under Item 3.5.1 were segregated by Expenditure Categories: MOOE and CO. Hence, there are line items for Item 3.5.1 sub-activities that are split to account for the specific MOOE and CO expenditures.
